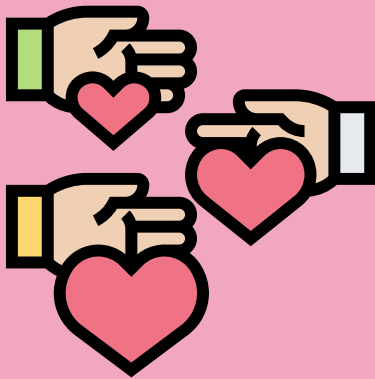
What to expect

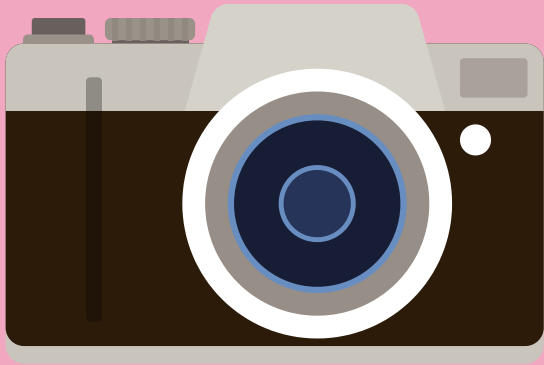


Photo Documentation

The festival is being documented.

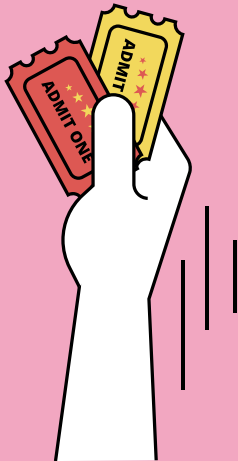
This means there may be people taking photos and videos when you are there.

Access Information



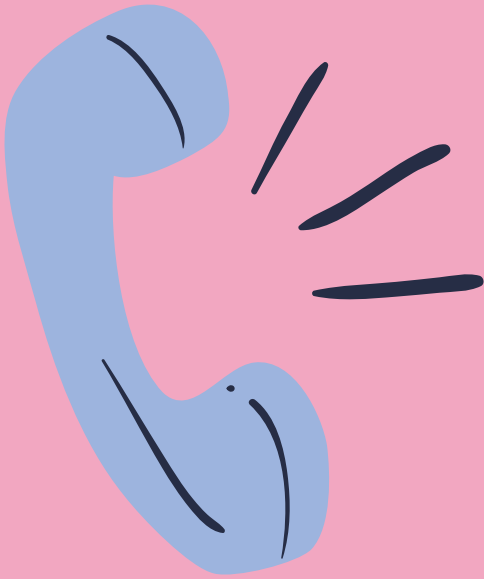
Most of our venues are wheelchair accessible and have accessible parking spaces nearby, as well as HEPA filters.
